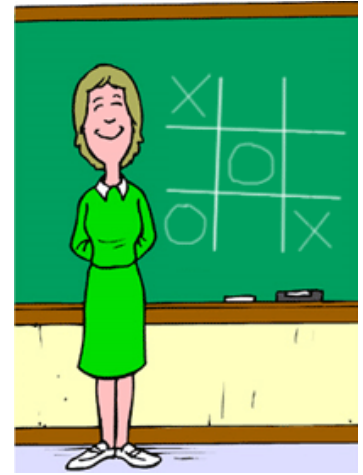


## Other Games

### Vocabulary Tic-Tac-Toe

Write nine vocabulary words on the board in a tic-tac-toe grid. Divide students into two groups –Xs and Os. Choose a team to go first. Have a student volunteer from that team choose a word from the grid. Student must use the word in a correct sentence that shows he or she understands the meaning of the word. When the student produces a correct sentence, erase the word from the grid and add an X or an O in its place, depending on the team. Then it's the other team's turn. The team with 3 Xs or 3 Os in a row wins.



**Play in pairs:** Student A chooses a vocabulary word and definition from the lesson and creates a sentence using the definition. For example, if the vocabulary word is planet, the student might say, "Last night I saw a large object orbiting the Sun." Student B then repeats the sentence using the vocabulary word, "Last night I saw a planet."



### Rush to the Board

Divide the students into three or four teams, depending on the number of students in your class. Line students up in their teams, facing the board. Give the first student in each line a piece of chalk. Give the definition of a word. The first student to get to the board and write the word correctly scores a point for his or her team.
