The Ed-Fi Alliance is a “community of educators, technologists, and leaders committed to ensuring that every teacher, school district, and state agency can see, secure, and use their data—regardless of what platform it’s built on.”¹ Through the Ed-Fi Data Standard, Ed-Fi has created a common language for educational data that helps educators connect previously siloed systems, from assessment and instructional solutions to student information systems. Ed-Fi also offers a set of tools to help educators more easily combine and visualize data from those independent systems. The result for educators is a comprehensive and flexible view of student data, all in one place.

We are excited to announce that our team is working to make data from Curriculum Associates’ products compliant with the Ed-Fi Data Standard so it is more easily accessible to educators using solutions built on Ed-Fi. Our hope is that this growing partnership will help educators deliver effective instruction for students with even greater efficiency.

? Which data will be Ed-Fi compliant?

We are working on making *i-Ready Diagnostic* outcome data Ed-Fi compliant. This means that scale scores, domain and overall placements, and Typical and Stretch Growth progress from *i-Ready Diagnostic* assessments will be supported.

? What is the timeline for Ed-Fi compliance?

We plan to offer fully functioning Diagnostic outcome interoperability with Ed-Fi in fall 2019.

? Can I use Ed-Fi to analyze my *i-Ready Diagnostic* data?

In order to use Ed-Fi, your school or district needs to be participating in a solution that leverages the Ed-Fi Data Standard. Two exciting examples are the Michigan Data Hub and the WISEdata Wisconsin Information System for Education. Our interoperability with Ed-Fi will ensure that we can securely send *i-Ready Diagnostic* outcome data to Ed-Fi-compliant systems, providing educators with easy access to student information and the ability to analyze it alongside valuable student data from other systems.
