## Alphabet Books

- 26 books in total (actual size: 7 " $\times 7$ ")
- Six copies of each Alphabet Book $=156$ books per classroom


## Alphabet Tales (Big Book)

Magnetic Reading Foundations' program-specific Big Book (one book per classroom; actual size: 18" x 15")

## Magnetic Readers (Program-Specific Decodable Readers)

15 titles with six copies of each $=90$ books per classroom (actual size: $8^{\prime \prime} \times 6.5^{\prime \prime}$ )

Simple and mostly visual little books that build concepts of print, alphabet knowledge, and oral language and help prepare students for the Magnetic Readers

- Alphabet Tales contains content from the Alphabet Books as well as additional content to teach the alphabet, such as songs and poems.
- This Big Book introduces each new letter and teaches concepts of print in a large format.

Magnetic Readers (Program-Specific Decodable Readers)

- 30 titles in total (actual size: $8^{\prime \prime} \times 6^{\prime \prime}$ )
- Six copies of each book $=180$ books per classroom
- Packaged by unit (i.e., 30 books)


## Card Sets: Grades K-2

Highly readable little books on connected topics that give children the opportunity to read about real things as they practice new phonics and high-frequency word skills

Sound Spelling Cards are used daily to introduce and review sound spellings. Sound Spelling Cards include a list of spellings for each sound along with an image to represent the sound.

Articulation Cards provide clear directions and visual examples of proper mouth formation for each sound in the program.

Word Building Cards can be used to practice letter recognition and spelling. Teachers use the Word Building Cards in the Encode Words part of sessions to model building, blending, and changing letters to spell new words before students practice writing words.

Super Word Cards for each high-frequency word taught in the program help students say, spell, and write each word. The cards include the word and context sentences to support meaning and usage.
